If you have been wondering about all the construction going on through and around the Southern parts of Citrus Springs, here is the answer. It is all part of the construction of a Natural Gas Pipeline that starts in Alabama and comes down the state of Florida to bring natural gas to the Florida Power and Light Company, other industrial users and local distribution companies. An attached smaller pipeline spur that is coming through Marion and Citrus County will supply Natural Gas to the Duke Energy plant (now under construction) in Crystal River.



What you are seeing now is the initial stages of construction that clears a working pathway space by removing trees and other vegetation and leveling the ground to allow the large digging and pipe installation equipment to operate. Once the pipe line is buried the earth above will be returned to its natural grades with an approximate 50 ft wide right of way kept clear. The Pipeline is snaking through parts of Citrus Springs following along the Duke Energy Power line pathway already in existence.

Just to let you know this is a Natural Gas line NOT a LIQUID Natural Gas Line. Big difference in all aspects of design, construction and safety.
